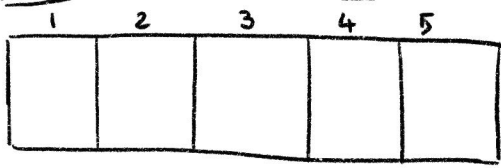

LIGHT TO DARK

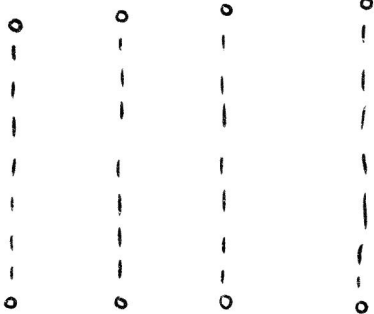


Light ← → Dark

- 1 CHOOSE ONE SHADE OF BLUE FROM YOUR PALETTE
- 2 EXPERIMENT WITH YOUR RATIO OF WATER TO PAINT TO MAKE THAT COLOUR LIGHTER OR DARKER

BRUSH-PRESSURE + POSITION

THICK ← → THIN

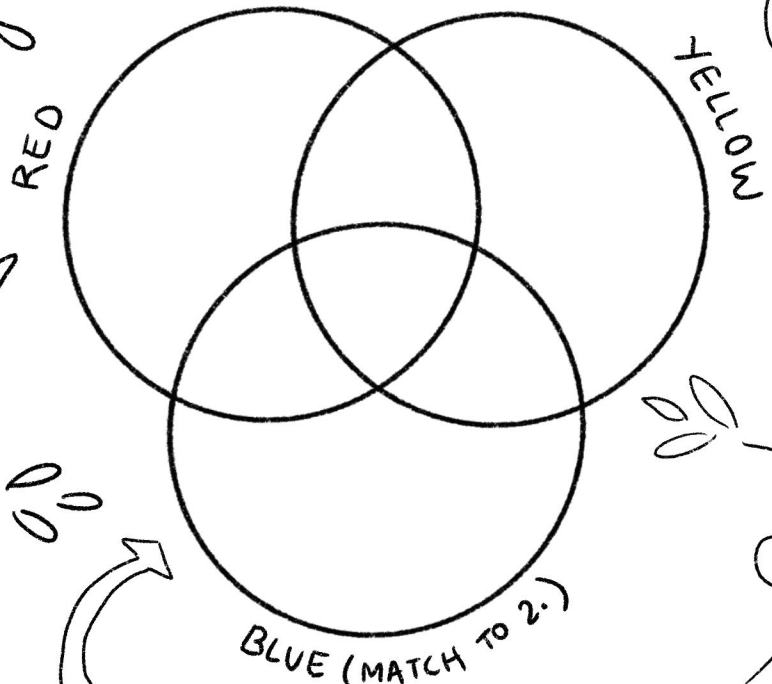


CHOOSE ONE BRUSH & SEE HOW THE PRESSURE & POSITION CHANGES THE THICKNESS

USE YOUR WATERCOLOUR PAPER TO MAKE SWATCHES

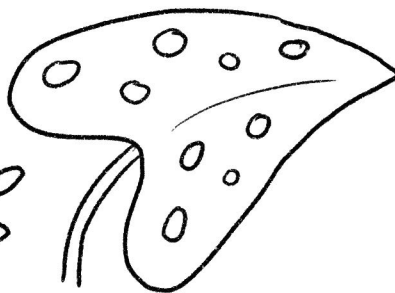
GLAZING + MAKING NEW COLOURS WITH LAYERS



TIP! LET ME DRY BEFORE ADDING OTHER COLOURS

USING LAYERS & NEGATIVE SPACE

- 1 PAINT THIS WHOLE LEAF YELLOW. LET DRY. THEN PAINT IT GREEN AROUND THE DOTS.



- 2 THIS TIME PAINT AROUND THE GREY STEM
↳ SEE HOW NOT USING PAINT CAN BE A USEFUL TOOL!
